#### WEIGHT DESIGNATION — PROVINCIAL HIGHWAY NO. 27

ORDER for Increasing Weight Designation on Provincial Highway No. 27.

**Reference:** Increasing weight limits on Provincial Highway No. 27 from its junction of Provincial Highway No. 41 to 525 m west of its junction of Provincial Highway No. 41.

Pursuant to section 35.1 of The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997, the Minister hereby Orders:

For the purpose of managing traffic on and protecting provincial highways, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that effective 12:01 a.m., May 11, 2017, unless restricted by a Minister's Order issued pursuant to *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, this Order authorizes any person, vehicle or class of vehicles to operate at the weights set for primary highways by *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations, 2010*, on Provincial Highway No. 27 from its junction of Provincial highway No. 41 to 525 m west of its junction of Provincial Highway No. 41.

This Order is issued on a permanent basis and will not be affected by Spring Road Restriction Orders.

- 4 All minimum live price notices shall include the date and time upon which the stated price becomes effective.
- 5 Provincial live prices shall be distributed to processors according to their provincial categorization.
- **6** No licensed producer shall sell, and no processor shall buy, live turkey at a price that is less than the minimum live price determined by the Board.
- 7 This Order will remain in effect for a period no longer than 12 months from the date this Order is approved by the Agri-Food Council.
- 8 Order No. 32/16: Minimum Live Price is repealed and replaced by this Order.
